

## Testimony by Mdm Tan

Beijing Prayer Trip (June3-10) was truly orchestrated by the Holy Spirit. When I came to know about the trip at the Seminar held in Suntec Convention Exhibition Centre, I was strangely drawn by the Spirit towards it. I shared it with my daughter, Jean. She prayed to God and laid a fleece before God. She prayed that if God wanted her to go, He would let her hear or see the word 'Beijing' three times consecutively starting from the day of her prayer. God miraculously answered her prayer.

Prior to the trip, in my daily devotions, the Lord seemed to highlight the number 7. Elijah sent his servant seven times to look toward the sea. On the seventh time, a cloud as small as a man's hand was rising from the sea. Naaman dipped himself seven times in the Jordan as Elisha had told him and his flesh was restored. Elisha told the Shunamite woman to go away as the Lord had decreed a famine in the land that would last for 7 years. At the end of the seven years, she came back from the land of the Philistines and everything was restored to her. It thrilled my heart when I found out that 7 of us were going on this prayer trip. God had handpicked five from Singapore and two from Malaysia. I felt that the trip was in the perfect will of God.

Jean and I met the five Singaporeans at the Changi airport. The first part of the trip (June3-June6 ) was a tour of some interesting sites in Beijing. We had excellent accommodation and food. ES and Rev. Jey met us for a brief moment during our visit to the Temple of Heaven. ES told us to stand at a particular spot to pray. It was at the Temple of Heaven that I told Rev. Jey that I like her book "Secrets of Praying Well". She asked me which part did I like. I replied the statement she made that prayers can break generational curses. I have always sensed that my family is under a generational curse.

The second part of the prayer trip started on 7 June. The first session started on Saturday afternoon. ES shared briefly and prayed for a local Chinese woman who had just accepted the Lord and brought an idol which was in a box to be destroyed. Then, a local Chinese lady shared her testimony about her marital problems.

After her testimony, ES asked us to align ourselves with the Holy Spirit. As I closed my eyes to pray, the Lord reminded me of two sisters in my church who had come to me for prayers and counsel. They also had marital problems. Then the Spirit came upon me. I felt warm and I was just weeping before God. I was deeply convicted of the sin of selfishness. I was always praying for I, me, myself and my family. I was like the typical church. When members came to us with their problems, we would give them the easy answer to look to God but we on our own, had never really stood in the gap for them. I had to practically plead with Jesus for forgiveness. It was a humbling experience. Jesus showed me the true condition of my heart. No wonder the bible says that the heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it? (Jer.17:9 )

On Sunday, we had to go to a house church. In the van, I sat opposite ES. There was a box between us. It was the box containing the idol brought by the local Chinese woman. As the latch was opened and I looked inside, I was shocked to see that the idol had many hands which was very similar to one of the Hindu idols in Malaysia. ES started to smash the idol in the box.

The memory of my battle against the Hindu spirits flooded into my mind. I recalled the time when we prayed for my brother and my mum manifested Hindu spirits. She trumpeted like an elephant and

danced and sang Hindi song. Fear just gripped me. I started praying softly throughout the journey to the house church. I was glad when we finally reached our destination.

The service was held in a beautiful house of a member. It was here that the true purpose of the prayer trip was unfolded. A Chinese lady was leading the worship and a Chinese man was at the piano. As I sat in one corner, suddenly the burden of prayer came over me. I wept. The Holy Spirit just put one word in my mind – “lasting”. I prayed earnestly for God to do a lasting work in this house church.

Then, ES led the service. He shared briefly and said that we were to do repentance prayer. He asked Jeremiah and Eliz who are Indians to repent on behalf of India for introducing idolatry to China. This was done in front of an elderly Chinese couple. The Chinese had to forgive India for this sin and repent for their sin of idolatry. He asked Emma to repent on behalf of Singapore. Jean and I represented Malaysia.

The awesome part was the spirit of repentance just fell upon us. Chinese, Singaporeans and Malaysians were weeping. I felt the warmth of the Holy Spirit. I knew the Lord initiated this prayer of repentance because when my turn came to repent, the Holy Spirit just took over. I could not repent on behalf of Malaysia. The Holy Spirit made me repent on behalf of the Chinese in China and South East Asia. As I was repenting, revelation of knowledge just came. The Lord revealed to me that the generational curse in my family is related to the Hindu Spirit (esp. the idol in the box. The name Siva crossed my mind). For years, I had just been mouthing repentance but this time the Holy Spirit was praying through me. The overwhelming demonstration of His presence was awesome. I never expected that I would experience this in Beijing.

Some might call this prophetic act foolish. I believe God is calling forth a people who will respond to His leading no matter how foolish, irrational or insignificant His command might seem to be. This symbolic act is linked with a spiritual battle for China. Prophetic act done under the unction of the Holy Ghost is powerful in the spiritual realm.

On Monday, by the mercy of God, Rev Jey taught us about generational curses. I was blessed by her teaching and the many precious spiritual gems that were in ES's sharing. On the last day, ES challenged us to transfer our lip service to action and to meditate on Isaiah 55:8 for seven years.

This prayer trip was about God's agenda and not our own. One thing I am certain. If we take care of God's agenda, He will take care of our agendas.

Jesus truly has many surprises in store for us when we obey Him. I leave Beijing with an assignment from God through ES to intercede for this anointed ministry. I am totally dependant on Jesus to be faithful to whatever He has asked me to do.

My testimony is addressed to the Body of Christ. I would strongly urge you to join future prayer trips organized by CCC Worldwide Trumpet Ministry. If you read this testimony and feel a tug at your heart to go, step forward in faith. God will surely meet with you in ways beyond your wildest dreams. You will discover as I did when I went to Beijing: the truth of Isaiah 55:8

*For My thoughts are not your thoughts,*

*Nor are your ways My ways,  
says the LORD.*

I thank God for giving me the opportunity to go to Beijing in June 2008 to experience first hand the lives of the mainland Chinese. Beijing is indeed a vibrant city. Many new buildings had been built and many more are under construction to prepare for the upcoming Beijing Olympic 2008. The hotel we stayed is brand new, world-class 5 star hotel. In the midst of all the modern infrastructures are the ancient historical sites like the Great Wall of China, Forbidden City and Temple Of Heaven. Indeed it is a unique city waiting for you to discover.

ES met us at the Temple of Heaven and shared about the history of the Temple of Heaven. The local China people were very curious. They stopped to listen to what was being shared. According to ES, the China people are hungry to hear something new because they are faced with many problems in their lives. Their souls are languishing and they are looking for a way out. The field of China is indeed ripe for harvest. The question is: “Are you willing to be the labourers?”

In our hearts, we silently prayed that the Spirit of the Lord will touch the hearts of the people. The message was shared to a lady but she was uneasy and she informed us that she had just embraced buddhism. Praise God! Through ES, the Lord had just rebuked the spirit of buddhism at this strategic place - the ancient place of worship to prove that the original God of Chinese people is the God of Heaven – 皇天上帝.

To confirm what was being accomplished at the Temple of Heaven, one of our China disciple who had just been converted brought two idols from her home for us to destroy– one was the goddess of mercy with thousand hands and the other was the statute of buddha. Hallelujah! These were the spoils from the enemy camp because we had won the victory!

In the second half of the trip, we stayed at a typical traditional Chinese architectural motel. The area was very tranquil and serene surrounded by mountains and lake. The food at the restaurant was simply delicious. Everyday we were literally feasting with great abundance of food. Before the trip, we were all geared up, prepared for the worst to ‘suffer’ for Jesus but the Lord surprised us with His goodness. We had a good time in the presence of the Lord, feasting upon His word and fellowship with the local Chinese believers. We got to hear firsthand, many wonderful testimonies from the local China disciples. Praise the Lord! The Spirit of the Lord has already established a strong base there and many ministries will be birthing forth through this small fellowship in the days ahead.

On Sunday, we had our church service at a disciple house. It was a very beautiful house. I was amazed

by their standard of living. Indeed the Lord has blessed them abundantly. It was a small gathering but the Spirit of the Lord was there to minister, convict and touch the hearts of the people. The highlight of the service was the repentance prayer. Jeremiah and Eliz were told to represent India and repented on behalf of India for disseminating Buddhism to China. The China believers were to represent China, Mdm Tan and Jean were to represent Malaysia and I was to represent Singapore to forgive India for introducing Buddhism to our nations. This again was a surprise to me because I was not told in advance about such a prophetic session. It was an awesome and defining moment. Following the previous two encounters, this again was a war waged against the spirit of buddhism. The Lord is determined to lay the axe to the root! I prayed that the Lord will set Singapore and India free from the spirit of idolatry, especially from the spirit of buddhism and to embrace Jesus Christ as Lord. May the Lord hear our prayers and send revival to the Chinese and Indian people worldwide.

ES concluded that our first Beijing Prayer Trip has been successfully completed. The will of God is done. To God be the glory!

### **Obedience to the call of God - Testimony by Jeremiah**

On April 11<sup>th</sup> 2008, my wife approached me and shared a dream she had to go to Beijing together with the CCC Worldwide Trumpet Ministry in June. I told her OK but we'll wait for the Lord's confirmation. I told her jokingly that if we hear this particular Tamil song which started off with Chinese lyrics, "Wah I a nee ha....", then we'll take it as a confirmation. I was truly joking but in my heart, I was 90% sure my wife will be going to Beijing.

The next day on April 12<sup>th</sup>, I was watching a Tamil dance program competition and they were dancing to this particular song. My God, my eyes & ears couldn't believe it and my wife was next to me laughing. I told her Ok and get ready for Beijing. We went to John Little's sale at Singapore Expo to relax with our kids. When we returned home, I was watching another Tamil talent program. To the surprise of my family, it was the same song again. All my family couldn't stop laughing. I was asking myself "Does our Heavenly Father allow us to joke with him?" I can strongly say YES. He is a loving and caring Father to all who obey Him.

On Sunday April 13<sup>th</sup>, I was having quiet time with the Lord. I asked Him for signs if I need to go to Beijing with my wife as I was facing struggles at my work place. I have been working in this company for 19 years. The management wanted me to sign a contract with some task to be completed in 3 months, failing which I would be terminated without any compensation benefits. This contract was signed on 19<sup>th</sup> March 2008 and the Beijing trip was in June 2008. This contract was the same contract that I was supposed to sign before going to the Korea Prayer Mountain in year 2007.

We have been going to Tiong Bharu Shopping Centre for lunch at a particular shop for the past 4 years on most Sundays. On this day while we were waiting for a table, we noticed that the name of the next shop was "Lao Beijing" in big letters. We couldn't believe our eyes and my wife told me looks like this is a confirmation for you. I said ok but will still wait. However, during worship time in church, I told the Lord that I would go to Beijing and didn't want to play about these things anymore. A prophecy came from behind us from a sister that was similar to the vision my wife had about the WIND OF HOLY SPIRIT while we were at Korea Prayer Mountain in year 2007. During the sermon, my pastor

suddenly mentioned "You want someone from China to come and tell you?" I looked at my wife and agreed we'll be going to Beijing.

On Monday April 14<sup>th</sup>, I sent my leave application for June 1<sup>st</sup> to June 10<sup>th</sup>. My big boss called me into his office and told me about the contract and emphasized on the sentence "termination" in my contract. I said I was aware of it and would try to finish whatever had been assigned to me before the leave. My leave was still pending to be approved.

I went back to my table and my heart was very troubled. I took the courage and sms to my wife this message "Can I resign from my job". To my greatest surprise, she replied "Go ahead. Just resign. Our God will provide". She also mentioned we could downgrade to a smaller flat. On my way home for lunch, I thought of what my wife said about selling our flat and downgrading to a smaller flat, with tears in my eyes. After lunch when I went back to my workplace, my mind was already set to leave my job if my leave for Beijing was not approved. I calculated my leave and set 23<sup>rd</sup> May to tender my resignation.

I have two children aged 11 and 13 years of age. I am the sole bread winner of the family with a savings of around \$5000/-. If I were to resign and take the \$5000/- to Beijing, my family would have nothing except our God to depend on. Even after taking into account this entire scenario, I still had peace in my heart. (Just to inform anyone reading this testimony, ES was not aware of any decision we were making). We emailed him about my wife's dream and vision to Beijing, eagerly waiting for his reply but realised he didn't receive our email as there was a sudden block to his e-mail id. We found out this only on 16<sup>th</sup> April when he arrived in Singapore.

We prayed hard and asked God to lead us in whatever decision we were making. On Tuesday April 15<sup>th</sup> I read the task again which I had to do. To my surprise, it looked very easy. My boss came to my table and asked me about the task. I replied that I was doing it with a friend helping me. I told my wife that we would not take any decision now but to wait upon the Lord for further instruction concerning my job.

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On 30<sup>th</sup> April I e-mailed one of my boss for my leave approval. I explained to him briefly that this was not a vacation, but has something to do with God's calling and that he will not understand even if I explained. I even told him I would approach the higher level boss for retrenchment if my leave could not be approved. He told me to see another boss the next day.

On 1<sup>st</sup> May the next day I went to work prayerfully. I met the other boss before starting work and asked him to approve my leave as it was very important for me and my wife to go to Beijing. He told me it was difficult and said "I can see your work attitude from this" I told him I choose God before my work. He replied he would look into it and walked away. I was very angry but continue with my daily work routine. One hour into my work, there was a major problem, I sensed it was related to my leave not being approved but I just prayed and continued with the recovery process.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> of May I prayed that God sent his angels to deal with all the people who were against me. There was another major problem in the system in which I have the expertise to handle. I realized the person

who made the mistake was one of those against me. All my bosses had to come to work on Sunday to find a solution to prevent this problem. To my surprise, they asked me to join in the conference to help find a preventive measure. I gave them 2 suggestions and they took both. Within 2 days I realized that another working colleague had to go for a heart bypass operation. A church member met with an accident. I realized that all these people were the ones working against me. I prayed to God that I was sorry for praying wrongly by using the word 'deal'. I also told the lady who made the mistake the she can't do anything now except to pray.

I called the big boss who has known me for more than 15 years that I would like to be in the retrenchment list. He replied that 'I just missed the boat' and will inform me if the next retrenchment came up. I fixed an appointment to meet him on the 5<sup>th</sup> of May and told him about my leave and the improvement plan I was in. He told me he will talk to my boss to help me. I replied him with parting words, "If I can't get my leave approved or retrenched, I will tender my resignation.

There was no news from anybody regarding my leave. I had an email from ES that if the company needs me, they will approve my leave and to tender my resignation only as the last resort. On the 13<sup>th</sup> of May the boss called me and I explained the importance of this trip. He told me that he would talk to the HR department and request that my improvement plan be extended till 30<sup>th</sup> June. I replied that if nothing can be done I would have to resign and go to Beijing.

I had an e-mail from a sister from CCC Worldwide Trumpet Ministry regarding the payment for the Beijing trip. I was very troubled that night. My wife sensed it and asked why I look so stressed. I told her that ES asked me to wait till the last moment before handing in my resignation but now this sister is asking for payment. She told me to just relax and go to bed. I woke up the next day and realized the agreement I had made with God that I would go to Beijing. So I wrote the cheque to the Ministry for the Beijing trip. My thoughts were since no matter what happens, I'll go to Beijing, so why delay the payment.

I had already planned to send in my resignation on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of May and I received a mail from my boss to see him on the 21<sup>st</sup> morning regarding my leave. All glory and honor be to our Lord Jesus! as I received the news that my leave had been approved. I told my boss that no one knew the pressure I was in waiting for this news.

Just to a few points: I was very troubled whenever I went to work. My thoughts were on how I was going to manage financially to support my family. But when I was at home, I was very at peace with my wife supporting and encouraging me. She kept on telling that our God will supply all our needs and not to bother about losing the job. This is one victory which I will never forget. All glory and honor be to our Lord Jesus Christ.

While in Beijing, we were at peace when we arrived at the airport. The tour to places of interest was not to my liking on the 1st day. But as the day came to an end, ES & Rev. Jey came to visit us in our hotel. My room was selected for a small briefing which lasted less than 30 minutes but the spirit of the whole team was lifted up by their presence and prayer. At the Temple of Heaven, we were again met by ES & Rev. Jey. Both Eliz and I were asked to prepare ourselves for Sunday service as we would be doing the repentance prayer to free India. Both of us held hands in the centre stone and shouted to our Lord for His special anointing and prayed very loudly.

On the 6<sup>th</sup> of June 2008, we were informed by ES that one of his disciple would pick us up to a special place. We were very excited. A brother came and introduced himself as Isaac. I felt like seeing an Angel. His face looked very glowing. We went to his home which was very peaceful and a room dedicated to people of God. We were told that a baptism had taken place in the bath tub. Wow, such a privilege.

On Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> June we had a communion service in a house which was very special. After the service both Eliz & I were asked to go to the centre of the hall to pray the repentance prayer. As I was lying prostrate, I could feel the heat and the presence of the Holy Spirit. As this was my 1<sup>st</sup> time doing such a prayer, I prayed that God guide me and prepare my heart, soul, mind and body. I was obedient to instruction and did what I was supposed to do with reverence to God. As I stood up after the prayer, Rev. Jey touched my shoulder. There was a special peace in my heart. My shirt was quite wet with perspiration. But I felt a special joy in my heart as being one chosen to do this prophetic intercession.

She gave me a form to apply and after I had finished filling up the form, I handed it to the Chinese lady. She took an approval stamp and stamp hard on that particular form "Leave Approved". I was surprised and when I woke up, I shared this vision with Jeremiah. We kept thanking God for this vision and continued praying that Jeremiah leave will be approved so that we can prepare for the Beijing trip. After much waiting, Jeremiah's leave was finally approved by God's intervention in his work place. "Hallelujah!" Praise The Lord!

During the stay in Beijing, we were advised on what to bring and what to do during the trip. God blessed this trip with a cooling weather though it was summer time. We were surprised by the clean hygiene though we were prepared for the worst. I guess God made everything beautiful in this trip for us.

In the Temple of Heaven, Jeremiah and I were encouraged to say the repentance prayer by ES. We felt very good when both of us shouted at the top of our voices to bless India. After I came back from Beijing, my mum and a few church friends complimented on my face that my face skin is radiant and glowing and am looking fairer than before! I knew in my heart that this must be the joy of the Lord and His divine beauty that added to my looks as I draw closer and closer to Him

When my daughter first told me to go to the Beijing Prayer Trip, I was very reluctant to go because I have been there before. Every 2 – 3 days I would knock on her door and tell her I don't wish to go. But she kept insisting I MUST go. She said she was paying for the trip and that God will meet me there. Reluctantly I prepared myself for the trip.

The first day we arrived in Beijing, I cried and cried. I kept thinking of my daughter and how I tried to get out of this trip. I thought of how my daughter loves me. I was embarrassed and didn't dare to cry too loudly, yet my tears couldn't stop. The next day ES asked me what was wrong with my eyes (they were puffy), I replied for crying too much the day before.

One day we were having prayer meeting at a house church. Everyone was kneeling except me. I was sitting in a chair because my legs were numb. As I bowed my head, I felt God telling me to kneel, so I knelt. As I knelt, I started to cry again. I told God I didn't know what to do or what to say, that I am so new to the faith. ## **Beijing, Beijing, Beijing! – Testimony by Jean**

The last time I went to China was in 1995 for a holiday with my mother. We visited the southern part of China. During our trip, both of us fell ill. My mom had diarrhea non-stop and I was vomiting throughout the trip to the extent that I had to seek injection from a doctor. Even then, my vomiting did not stop. Our bodies could not adapt to the food and the environment and hence it was a rather unpleasant holiday for us. From then on I told myself that I will never go to China again.

On the Sunday afternoon of February 24, 2008, my mom invited me to join her for an 8 days Prayer trip to Beijing organised by CCC Worldwide Trumpet where we will learn to intercede for the Chinese people. Immediately I responded negatively and reminded her of our bad experience during our last trip to China. My mother remembered our experience but she mentioned that she was somehow drawn to this trip and she has even registered her name without having a friend to go with.

I told my mum that I would pray about it and let her know. After all it has been quite some time since we went for a mother and daughter trip. But deep in my heart I told God, “not China again Lord, but instead send me to Korea Prayer Mountain which I’ve heard so much.”

That same day while waiting to meet up with an ex-colleague who was late for our dinner appointment, I prayed to God, “Please tell me if it is your will for me to go to China. Speak to me and I will obey”. I wanted a confirmation and laid a fleece before the Lord “Lord, if it is your will for me to go to Beijing, then let me hear or see the word “Beijing” 3 times consecutively in the next 3 days starting from that evening itself”. I thought that as it was already late, it would be rather impossible for me to see or hear “Beijing”. But if it does happen, then I would know that God is speaking.

When my ex-colleague finally arrived, we started catching up and suddenly she mentioned that her friend had just got back from Beijing. I could not believe my ears and got her to repeat her sentence. I was very surprised to hear the word Beijing but thought that perhaps it was just a coincidence and left it as that.

The next day I went to work, forgetting all about my fleece, But God did not forget. In the midst of my busy Monday morning, I received a call from my friend. Through the middle of our conversation she mentioned that her sister-in-law had gone back to Beijing. Again, I asked her to repeat her sentence just to make sure that I did hear the word Beijing.

After that conversation, I couldn’t believe my ears and decided to share with a close colleague of mine, Yin, who is also a Christian. I shared how I had laid a fleece before God and He had allowed me to hear the word “Beijing” twice in 2 consecutive days.

The next day during lunch time that Yin started teasing me if my third “Beijing” came. I gladly told her not yet and was quite relieved about it. While we were walking and talking about this, I pulled out a contest form at the side of the hypermarket aisle. I flipped the contest form over and behold! The grand prize for the contest was a trip to Beijing! I showed it to Yin and both of us burst into laughter. Praise the Lord! He answered my fleece and showed me Beijing 3 times. Beijing! Beijing! Beijing!

With that, I confidently informed my mom that I’ve decided to obey God and to go Beijing with her.

After that day, I never heard or saw the word Beijing anymore. God is great! Even in the midst of our busy schedules, He cares and guides His children when we seek Him. He is truly a prayer-answering God.

I wrote to ES to sign up for the Beijing Prayer trip with my mum. Few weeks later, ES called to say that he would be in town and would like to meet up with us. I had never met ES before. I invited my husband and my mom invited her friend to the meeting. Over dinner, ES shared with us about the trip and his ministry. We were very encouraged and blessed by his sharing. ES closed with a prayer and he prophetically said that God had answered all our prayers that night. I received that prayer by faith as there were a few things in my heart that night which I hope to get answers from God when I go to Beijing. My husband and I had been crying out to the Lord for a child and have even dedicated our child to God in advance. I had suffered two miscarriages and I recognized that barrenness is a curse which only God can break. It was also my heart's desire to know what is God's will for my life.

It was truly an amazing trip ordained by God. There were seven (perfect number) of us in the trip. There was a couple in our trip, Jeremiah and Eliz, who shared their testimony of how they struggled in child bearing and God gave them victory. I was very encouraged by their testimony.

On the first four days of the trip, the seven of us toured around Beijing, visiting the popular sites. The next four days of our trip was the main highlight. It was on 8 June when we attended the Sunday service at the house church that ES told us to do a symbolic repentance. Jeremiah and Eliz repented on behalf of India for introducing Buddhism to China and the rest of us were to repent before God on behalf of our ancestors for worshipping idols. The repentance session was really anointed. We could feel the presence of the Holy Spirit and something great happened in the spiritual realm that day.

The next day, Rev. Jey taught us about generational curses. It was really an eye-opener and we learnt how to break generational curse through prayer and good works. My mom asked me if the Lord had spoken to me. I told her not specifically but I thanked God that he delayed my menses which was supposed to come on the first day of our trip. In fact the menstrual pads that I brought along to the trip were given away to a sister who needed them. Coupled with my loss of appetite towards the end of the trip, two thoughts came to my mind, either I was falling ill (like what happened in Kun Ming) or there is a chance that I'm pregnant.

When we got home to Malaysia, the loss of appetite did not leave and my menses did not come either. I decided to take a home pregnancy test and it showed positive results. Immediately I went to see my gynecologist who confirmed that I'm 6 weeks pregnant. So far, the pregnancy has been good. What was supposed to happen in 6 weeks is now happening. However the gynecologist told me that I should wait for another two weeks to see the baby's heart beat before confirming that my pregnancy. Two weeks came and I went for my check-up. The gynecologist confirmed that the baby is growing well with a healthy heart beat. Praise the Lord! He answered my longing for a child and that it is His will for me to be a mother! God showed me that "Not by might nor by power but by His Spirit", He has made this conception possible. As I recap, it was really a miracle how I pulled through the Beijing Prayer Trip in my condition.

For those of you reading this testimony and you too have an intense desire to have a child, rise up and pray for your family. Claim the promises of God and like what ES taught us, believe in the Word of God

fanatically. God is there to back up his Word. I learn that the fruit of obedience is blessing. I encourage you to go for the next Beijing Prayer Trip. You never know what God has in store for you.
